SPECIAL PROVISIONS

Article 1

Financial support from Regulation (EC) N° 614/2007 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 23 May 2007 concerning the Financial Instrument for the Environment (LIFE+) is hereby granted to project proposal No **XXXXXX**, title: **XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX**, received on **XXXXXX**, (“**the project**”) as described in Annex I. The co-ordinating beneficiary accepts the grant and undertakes to do everything in its power to carry out the project, as described in Annex I, acting on its own responsibility.
